

SELECTION CRITERIA – 2018 JR PAN PACIFIC CHAMPIONSHIPS



Competition	2018 JUNIOR PAN PACIFIC CHAMPIONSHIPS to be held in SUVA (FIJI) . The swimming events will take place Aug 23-27, 2018.

Selection Events	BASA sanctioned qualifying meets only
Eligibility	<p>To be considered for selection, a swimmer must meet all of the following eligibility criteria:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Be a Bermuda citizen who is eligible to represent Bermuda in the Competition as per FINA General Rule 2 (GR2). 2. Be available to fulfill the Team Commitments as listed below and any additional commitments following selection. 3. Not used or administered any substance which, if it had been detected as being present in the athlete's body tissue or fluids, would have constituted doping, or used any prohibited method or committed any other doping offence as defined in BSADA or FINA's Anti-Doping Bylaw.
Team Commitments	<p>All swimmers must:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Comply with the provisions of the BASA Code of conduct at all times. 2. Conform to BASA requirements regarding team participation. This includes, but may not be limited to, providing an acceptable training plan, attendance at a pre-event camp and wearing team uniform as required. 3. Make themselves available for all team activities designated by BASA. 4. Not act in such a manner as to bring the athlete or BASA into public disrepute.

Performance Requirements	<p>Criteria for selection for 2018 Jr Pan Pacific Swimming Championships, for individual events:</p> <p>Qualifying period is May 1st, 2017 to June 10th, 2018. The swimmer must be between the age of 14-18 on the first day of competition.</p> <p>Selection for individual events at the 2018 Jr Pan Pacific Swimming Championships, will be as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Swimmers must reach the AAAA time in the 17-18 age group. 2. Swimmers can qualify and be considered for ranking with SCM, SCY and LCM times set during the qualification period. All times will be converted using Hytek to LCM for ranking. 3. A maximum of 3 swimmers per event may be considered for selection. <p>Nomination for Other Events:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. At the sole discretion of BASA OTC, swimmers who qualify for the 2018 Jr Pan Pacific Championships on the above basis may be entered to swim additional events (events in which they haven't achieved the qualifying criteria) if there is an available position. Decisions about additional events will be made by BASA OTC in consultation with the National Head Coaches.
Team Size	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Team size for individual events will be in accordance with FINA rules.

	<p>2. The selection of athletes that have met all of the Eligibility and Performance Requirements will be announced at the conclusion of the qualifying period by the Bermuda Amateur Swimming Association.</p>
Notes	<p>1. Bermuda Amateur Swimming Association may amend these selection criteria at any time in its sole discretion by giving adequate notice to those swimmers who meet the eligibility criteria.</p> <p>2. If a swimmer is unable to satisfy BASA requirements after selection and needs to withdraw from the team, BASA may at their discretion select the next swimmer who has met all the eligibility and performance requirements. BASA reserve the right to request that any swimmer being considered for selection under the provisions of this clause undertakes a fitness test, the parameters of which will be determined by the National Team Coach at his/her sole discretion.</p> <p>In the event of illness or injury a medical certificate will be requested, indicating the current and future performance impact of the condition.</p> <p>Selection of a swimmer, as outlined above, will be subject to confirmation of their satisfactory return to training.</p>
Relays	Relays will be made up from the team that is qualified and selected.
